LEADSmart App is LIVE!

The Lead Alliance has created a LEADSmart App to enable families to track and monitor lead levels and give you information on living safely with lead.

What does the app do?

The app allows you to:

- Create a profile for you and each member of your family
- Record and track blood lead level test results over time
- Know the facts about 'living smart' and limiting your lead exposure
- Receive reminders for your next recommended test date
- Send appointment information to your personal smartphone calendar
- Receive notifications about Lead Alliance programs, events and news
- Share the app on Facebook

Use your smartphone, iPad or tablet to navigate to the Apple App Store, then search for LEADSmart. Or use Google Play to search for LEADSmart. You can also find it under the 'health and fitness' category.
